## March against the labor law on Saturday April 9

The movement against the government's planned labor law is gaining momentum, with then next major demonstrations planned for this Saturday at the behest of seven national unions and youth organizations.

Don't be fooled -- cosmetic changes haven't altered the nefarious essence of this proposed reform. Stripping the labor code of all protections for employees in terms of working hours and wages, workplace health and safety, and job protection will not create the new jobs that France needs to recover and grow. It will only create legions of low-paid, insecure laborers.

The parallels with the situation at AFP are clear for all to see: management's renunciation last year of 117 labor agreements is aimed at making us "work more for less".

Despite pouring rain more than one million employees and youths who took to the streets on March 31 to voice their opposition to the labor law, including AFP unions which marched together in Paris under a joint banner also decrying plans to cut our wages and benefits.

So join us this weekend to vote NO with your feet to a future of insecurity and inequality.
